

Dues are a small fee that Key Club Members are required to pay to belong to Key Club International. In the Illinois-Eastern Iowa District each member must pay a total of \$12 (\$7 goes to International and \$5 goes to the District). You can also charge an additional amount for funds for your own club.

Dues are used to fund district events and to create and distribute Key Club promotional information internationally. 
Fall Leadership Rally

Youth Opportunities Fund



The Youth Opportunity Fund (YOF) gives Key Clubs an alternate source of funding. The committee typically funds clubs who are seeking a portion of the total costs of a project or clubs working with other organizations to complete a project, such as Kiwanis, Circle K or Builders Club. After a grant is requested the Key Club International Board will consider your project and you will receive a grant.

Key Club Service Partners: Spastic Paralysis

Spastic Paralysis is a symptom of various diseases and medical conditions of the central nervous system. Research grants have spanned projects focusing on illnesses such as brain tumors, spina bifida, and Alzheimer's disease to genetic causes of mental retardation. The I-I Kiwanis created the Spastic Paralysis Research Foundation in 1952 to fund and support medical and scientific researchers dedicated to the research of spastic paralysis and other diseases related to the central nervous system. This has been our District Project for the past 30 years and through our involvement many technologies have become advanced. In the last two years the I-I District has raised nearly \$50,000!
