From the Yuda Band website, "A Yuda Band is a handmade leather and coconut bracelet from Guatemala, and the basis for a service learning project run by youth in high schools, jr highs, and middle schools across the United States. Yuda is derived from "aYUDA", the Spanish word for help, aid or assistance. Sales from Yuda Bands are used to build scholarship funds for youth in developing nations who would otherwise be unable to continue their education beyond the end of public education (6th grade) because of financial circumstances".
